Referral Guidelines

1. Must be a person that has made significant contributions of statewide or local impact on public education, students or for Association members in the state of New Jersey. If nominee is an agency, corporation or service club, please provide name of contact person.
2. The contribution must be of significant stature and the nominator must provide specific reasons as to why the nominee should receive the award.
3. The award may be conferred upon persons in the political, business, or civic community, or upon any supporter of public education.
4. Nominations will be evaluated on the basis of the criteria as stated and will not be considered unless criteria are met.
5. The Friends of Education Recognition Committee reserves the right to seek additional information on the nomination.
6. Only one award can be given per candidate.
7. All local Associations are asked to nominate a minimum of one (1) candidate for recognition.

MCEA Recognition Awards

Nominees can be nominated for recognition using one of the following criteria:

1. An individual, group, or business who strives to promote or improve public education in the Monmouth County community.
2. An advocate who in their day-to-day life inspires others to make a difference by engaging key stakeholders in discussions to promote policies that support the improvement of the great public schools that serve Monmouth County.
3. An active MCEA member whose ability to affect a positive difference with the students, parents, and colleagues that they encounter in the public-school setting has improved public education for the Monmouth County community.
